

The Glenn County HRA expects to receive approximately \$3,081,572 in ARRA funding. These funds will all be distributed throughout Glenn, Colusa, & Trinity Counties, with the exception of the HMIS funds as reflected below. All funding is intended to positively impact community members, businesses, and the general local economy. ARRA funds are intended to create jobs, stimulate the local economy, and serve individuals who have been heavily impacted by the economic downturn. The Agency strives to promote transparency and accountability with its use of ARRA funds to ensure taxpayer dollars are spent appropriately.
